

## A brief history of Japanese Whisky

- 1899 Shinjori Torii established Torri Shoten in Asoka. This will later evolve into Suntory.
- 1918 Shinjori Torii invested his family fortune to pursue his dream to make Japanese whisky.
- 1919 The White Oak distillery is the first distillery that was licensed to produce whisky. From that moment on they started to produce blended whisky from imported whisky.
- 1923 The construction of the Yamazaki Distillery started in Yamazaki in the outskirts of Kyoto.
- 1924 Together with Masatake Taketsuru, Shinjori Torii started producing whisky.
- 1929 Shinjiro Torii launched Suntory Shirofadu and failed because it didn't fit into Japanese tastes.
- 1934 Masatake Taketsuru established the Yoichi Distillery in Hokkaido.
- 1935 Mercian Corporation established the Kawasaki Distillery.
- 1937 Shinjori Torii launched Suntory Kukabin and became the country's no.1 selling whisky.
- 1941 The Akuto Family, which were making sake from 1600's, established the Hanyu Distillery under the careful watch of Isouji Akuto.
- 1949 Shinshu, Mars Distillery was established in Kagoshima.
- 1955 Karuizawa distillery was established by Mercian Corporation.
- 1969 Masatake Taketsuru established his 2nd distillery Miyagikyo in the Sendai region.
- 1972 Suntory established the Sun Grain Chita distillery and is only producing single grain whisky. This also the location where Suntory makes the Hibiki Blend.
- 1973 The Hakushu distillery was established by Suntory in the forest of Mount Kaikoma. The second name of the distillery is; the forest distillery. Kirin established the Fuji Gotemba distillery at the foot of Mount Fuji.
- 1977 Tochigi Distillery was opened by Masatake Taketsuru and was his last project. This is the location where the blend, store and age there blended whisky Taketsuru.
- 1984 Shinshu, Mars Distillery moved all the whisky production to Nagano. Also the White Oak distillery established a new distillery to produce single malt whisky's.
- 1989 To honor the 90th anniversary of Suntory, Suntory released the Hibiki 17yrs blended whisky.
- 1992 Shinshu, Mars distillery stopped producing whisky due to lack of demand.
- 2000 Hanyu distillery and Karuizawa stopped production of whisky and closed doors. Mercian Corporation stopped producing whiskey and was later sold to Kirin.
- 2004 Ichirio Akuto established the ChiChiBu distillery in ChiChibu.
- 2008 Ichirio Akuto bought most stock from his families closed distillery Hanyu but also from the Karuizawa and the Kawasaki distillery.
- 2009 Hibiki 21yrs won the best whisky in the world award.
- 2010 Shinshu, Mars Distillery reopened after an reorganisation and started producing whisky once again.
- 2016 Kurayoshi Distillery launched their whisky brand Matsui
- Loads of things are happening in the world of whisky. Age statements are not being produced anymore or produced in small quantities and new distillery's are established in Japan.



Please note that Japanese whisky with an age statement are hard to get. We try to keep our whisky menu as accurate as possible, but it can happen that we run out of stock and that the whisky you want is not available at that moment.

We offer flights in our menu. The flight consists of three whisky's of 15 ml each from the same company with the same age statement or close to the same age.

### Special serves

#### Highball

This is the most popular serve for whiskies in Japan. The whisky is stirred with crystal clear ice and gently topped up with chilled soda water. The carbonation is bringing the whisky to life. This is a perfect serve for a smoky or peaty whiskys. Suggested Whisky's : Suntory Hakushu and Nikka Yoichi

#### Mizuwari

The whisky is mixed with chilled still water. This serve suits more delicate malts. Suggested Whisky's : Suntory Yamazaki and Nikka Miyagikyo

#### On The Rock

We serve the whisky on a crystal clear ice ball. The ice ball cools the whisky without diluting it too much.
